




Grab your gear and get ready to grind! The park features a world-class, competition-scale Texas-shaped bowl with a full pipe, a 12-foot vertical ramp, a 10-foot-deep bowl, banked walls & speed hips - plus backyard-style pools & 3 flow bowls - beginner, intermediate, & advanced. A section designed to emulate the street-skating experience has ledges, rails, benches, banks, quarter pipes & stair obstacles, providing fun and creative challenges for skaters of all levels and interests.

In addition to the multi-level features, the Park is home to "High Noon" - a life-size, full pipe bronze sculpture designed by legendary skateboarder Steve Olson.

Admission is free. Helmets are required.
